

KENVALE COLLEGE ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS

All applicants for study at Kenvale College are required to provide evidence of their English language proficiency.

Applications will be approved by the Admissions Department based on the evidence of English language proficiency submitted as part of the admissions process.

Applicants unable to demonstrate the required level of English language proficiency as per this policy, will be advised to complete required ELICOS training before starting their course at Kenvale College.

Kenvale College reserves the right to request any applicant or existing student to sit an approved English language test to satisfy our English language requirement in case of any doubt about their English language proficiency presented throughout the admissions process.

All language test scores must be current and achieved within two years of the commencement of the course start date.

Kenvale College may issue a Conditional Letter of Offer (LoO) under the following circumstances, when:

- a) an applicant has provided evidence of studies at an ELICOS program with one of Kenvale College approved partners (section 2 below) prior to starting a course with Kenvale College;
- b) an applicant still has to complete an ELICOS program with one of Kenvale College approved partners (section 2 below);
- c) English Language Proficiency requirement is yet to be provided.

Kenvale College reserves the right to request applicants to undertake an English Placement test in case they have finished an ELICOS program with a non Kenvale partner.

The applicants will only be accepted at Kenvale College if the English proficiency level is achieved prior to the commencement of their intended course. Kenvale College has the right to rescind the offer and/or not allow the applicant to commence the course if the evidence requirements are not fulfilled.

The English language proficiency requirements are as per ONE of the following:

1) Complete an approved English Proficiency test from the following table:

2) Study at an approved English Language Centre from the following table:

3) Complete an approved Qualification with a specific English score listed in the following table:

4) Australian vocational qualifications

Where an applicant can provide a completed Certificate IV qualification (or higher) from the Australian Qualifications Framework issued within two years of starting an Kenvale College course, the applicant will be accepted into Kenvale College without having to prove English language proficiency.

5) Exemption of English proficiency evidence

An applicant who is a citizen of, and who holds a valid passport issued by the following countries will not be required to present any English evidence as part of their application with Kenvale College:

- (i) the United Kingdom;
- (ii) the United States of America;
- (iii) Canada;
- (iv) New Zealand; or
- (v) the Republic of Ireland;
